



QuickHold User Guide

What's New in QuickHold 3.0.1

Fixed a major issue with installation on systems with GateKeeper enabled.

IMPORTANT

Before installing QuickHold, you must either control-click the app's icon and choose [Open](#) to bypass GateKeeper and allow the app to run, or set GateKeeper to allow apps from [Anywhere](#).

Gatekeeper settings can be found in [System Preferences -> Security and Privacy -> General -> Allow apps downloaded from:](#).

If you do not perform either of these steps, the app may not run properly.

How to Install

Drop the [QuickHold](#) icon onto the Applications folder to install QuickHold. Open the app and follow the instructions to install the QuickHold Widget.

How to Uninstall

To safely remove QuickHold from your computer, delete [QuickHold](#) from your Applications folder. QuickHold and its accompanying widget are now completely removed from your Mac.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
QuickHold won't start or is not in your Applications folder	Re-install QuickHold
QuickHold shows a <i>File Damaged</i> error	See <i>IMPORTANT</i> on page 2
Error message: <i>"QuickHold.app" can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer</i>	See <i>IMPORTANT</i> on page 2
None of the above solutions solve your problem	Contact support
